

Plan of Action:

- 1. The first day of a brand-new session in the college for the incoming batch of students is memorable. Starting college can cause much anxiety in the heart of college student because of the unknowns. College conducted an Orientation Programme for the B.Ed. (Sem.-III) and M.Ed. (Sem.-III) students on 4th August, 2020. Dr. Rajni Khunger and Mr. Ajaydeep oriented the students regarding online regular classes. They informed the students about curricular and co-curricular aspects of the course. They also discussed the time-table with them. The programme concluded with an interactive mentor-mentee session. After the orientation, the students started attending the regular classes in their respective sections from 5th August, 2020.
- 2. On 16th August, 2020, NSS unit and Women Empowerment Cell DSCEW, Fzr in collaboration with NSS Deptt., P.U., Chandigarh organized a Webinar on 'Women's Rights' dedicated to 74thIndependence Day at 11:00 a.m. at Google meet platform. Dr. Jaswinder Kaur, Assistant Prof., G.H.G. Institute of Law for Women, Sidhwan Khurd, was the Resource Person in this webinar. She said that discrimination against women and girls is a pervasive and long-running phenomenon that characterizes Indian society at every level. While increasing representation of women in the public



spheres is important and can potentially be attained through some form of affirmative action, an attitudinal shift is essential for women to be considered as equal with in their homes and in broader society. She awakens the students about women's fundamental rights enshrined by United Nations.

- 3. IQAC and Research cell organized a One Day Webinar on the topic 'Experimental Research' on 24th August, 2020 at 11:00 a.m. The Resource Person Dr. Yogesh Sharma, Associate Prof., Ram Gariah College of Education, Phagwara, delivered the lecture on Google meet platform. The purpose of the webinar was to enhance the understanding of researchers' research methods and designs skills. M.Ed. students along with the faculty members joined the webinar. The webinar included presentation and a brief Question and Answer session.
- 4. On 27th August, 2020 IQAC and Placement Cell organized a One Day National Webinar on 'Soft Skill Development and Career Building'. The Resource Person Dr. Nandita Deb, Assistant Prof. & HOD Deptt. of Education, Shishu Ram Das College, University of Calcutta, West Bengal discussed in detail about the given topic on Googlemeet platform. She told us that some of the most sought-after soft skills in development include flexibility and adaptability, cross-cultural sensitivity and verbal and written communication. She even emphasized that there is need to analyze the role of current teaching methods in soft skill development and demonstrated the importance of incorporating soft skills in to institutional learning goals.
